Preparing for Baltimore

The ICC Annual Conference is in Baltimore, MD from November 1-4 with code development hearings before and after.

Some of the highlights of the Annual Meeting are:

- Elections for the ICC Board of Directors — Candidates are running for several Director seats with the elections to be held at the Annual Meeting. One duty of an ICC Chapter is to participate in this process by nominating, supporting, and voting for these candidates. This year, the BSA-VT Board has chosen to follow the path of the Eastern States Building Officials Federation (ESBOF) while we learn more about the process. Their support is extended to [Ron Piester](#), who was instrumental in supporting our early goal of becoming an ICC Chapter.
- Bylaws — Following some interesting events last year in Minneapolis at the ICC Final Code Hearings, changes have been made. The Board of Directors voted to forward proposed bylaws changes to Articles II, X and XVIII to a full vote of the membership commencing with the Annual Business Meeting in Baltimore, Maryland, on November 3, 2009. The proposed changes include language regarding Governmental Members and their Voting Privileges. For the complete set of proposed changes [click here](#).
