

Dear Member,

As you may know, our 1st Annual Meeting is coming quickly. While many details are now complete, our planning is dependent on your attendance. Currently, we have plans in place for 60 members and guests. Your early registration – this week would be great! – will greatly improve the efficiency of our efforts!

I believe that this meeting is vital to our membership and organization for several reasons:

1. ICC BSA-VT is truly fortunate to have the opportunity to meet, greet and hear from our keynote speaker, ICC CEO Rick Weiland. Please take this opportunity to learn from someone who has a national perspective on issues that we are currently dealing with in Vermont. He is a very busy man and it is hard to get out of the office these days. Help us welcome Rick to Vermont!
2. The ARRA Stimulus incentive has accelerated many programs throughout Vermont and New England, with far-reaching implications. Some of those implications are still being created in new legislation in Congress. This week, many bills are being heard on the floor of the House of Representatives that will directly impact our lives – energy, code administration, housing – new and existing thermal envelope requirements, ADA and more.
3. Our panel of speakers is exceptional! Vermont and our Association can benefit from their experience and viewpoints. With staff monitoring the action in Congress, our speakers have a direct line to the latest information on what is happening and how it may affect us.
4. The panel discussion and keynote address are precursors to our Fall meeting this September in Berlin – 9/10, 3 pm – when we will have another panel discussion with leaders from Vermont to explore answers to lingering questions.

Another key issue is the election of officers and Board of Directors for the coming year --

Our current Board is listed on the website, www.buildsafevt.org. Our bylaws call for 9 seats on the Board, with a balance (3 seats each) of code administrators, industry (builders and suppliers), and design professionals. We have three top-notch code administrators who stepped up to serve on the Board, joining a representative of Efficiency Vermont, and two housing professionals. That means we are operating with 3 vacant seats. If you are a design professional who wants to develop efforts to help the building industry in Vermont, I urge you to participate.

We need your nominations and your votes (balloting will take place at the meeting). Nominations are being taken NOW! If you are willing to serve on the Board of Directors and have an impact on our future, please send (via email) a short bio (similar to what you see on the website), a digital photo, and a letter explaining your interest and thoughts for the future of BSA-VT to Ryan Borkowski (Ryan.Borkowski@HanoverNH.org). Our bylaws state that Board members must also be members of ICC (national), but that requirement can be established after election and is not a prerequisite.
