**First Integrated Green Construction Code Poised For 2010 Debut**

The ICC launched its International Green Construction Code (IGCC) initiative on June 29<sup>th</sup>, which will reduce energy usage and the carbon footprint of commercial buildings. Entitled "IGCC: Safe and Sustainable by the Book," the initiative is committed to develop a model code focused on new and existing commercial buildings.

Drafters of the International Code Council's International Green Construction Code (IGCC) are nearing completion of the first-ever integrated green code for traditional and high-performance commercial buildings, set for a public release in March 2010. Read more:
